



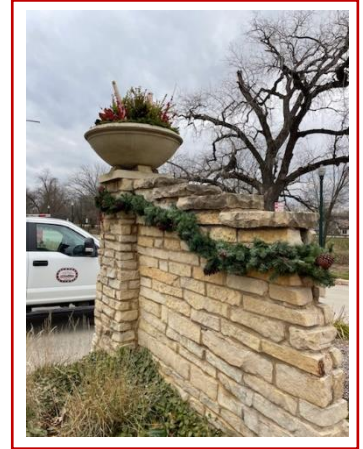
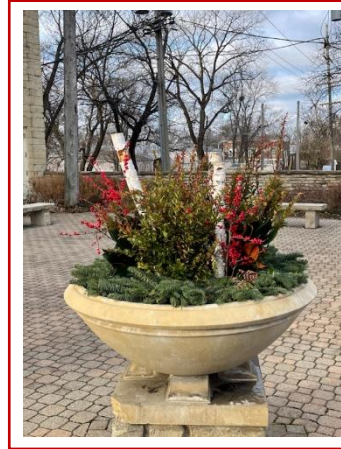

Department Updates

In addition to leaf pickup, our **Street Department** has been **repairing streetlights** this week to ensure safe roadways as we continue to lose those precious daylight hours. Speaking of lights...make sure to **check out the holiday lights & beautiful planters** our crew has set up! Visit **City Hall** or take a stroll down **State Street** to discover all the holiday spirit the City of Lockport has to offer – ‘tis the season!



The **Water Department** had a busy week **performing a multitude of assessments** to confirm **newly installed water main** is operating properly. Our water operators executed a series of **flushing, chlorination, pressure tests, and sampling** of the new water mains located at **11th Street (Downtown Streetscape Project), 163rd Street (Silo Bend), and New Avenue (Blue Label Cigar Lounge)**. These tests are necessary to ensure **optimal water flow and quality** as the new main is incorporated into our water system.



Updates continue over at the **Sewage Treatment Plant** with a **new and improved fuel tank setup**. A contractor poured a **new concrete pad** and hooked up the electrical. The **STP crew** utilized their **new crane truck** to place the fuel tanks onto the pad and ran **new electrical conduit** to it. This reformed placement is much more **organized and safe** due to the secure mounting of the tanks.

Project & Development Updates

- **2022 Resurfacing Project** - Pavement marking has been completed on 151st St, only minor landscaping items remain.
- **Public Works & Engineering Parking Lot Expansion** - Curb and binder installation have been completed. Temporary pavement marking and lighting were completed this week.
